

BQPP 2017: OBGYN Points Allocation Summary

BQPP Reimbursement Levels:

- Level 1 - sign the Network Participation Agreement (standard fee schedule)
- Level 2 - 600 points needed
- Level 3 - 800 points needed

The points are allocated in the following four categories (see table for details):

- PCMH Recognition or ACOG Scope program = 225 points
- Improving Health Outcomes = OBGYN up to 395 points/GYN up to 305
- Improving Patient Experience = up to 125 points
- Access = up to 200 points
- Reducing Cost = up to 400 points
- **Total Possible Achievable = OBGYN 1345 points/GYN 1255**

| Reducing Cost | <p>Practice Cost Report- Evaluation of the cost efficiency & utilization metrics of a practice in comparison to peer groups across North Carolina. Practices must meet and maintain both criteria below:</p> <p>1 year action plan if practice is above 1.17</p> | <p>Cost Index of 0.93 or below=400 points</p> <p>0.94- 1.01= 325</p> <p>1.02- 1.09= 275</p> <p>1.10- 1.17= 125</p> <p>1.18- 1.30=75</p> |
