

BQPP 2017: Family Medicine/Pediatrics Multispecialty Points Allocation Summary

BQPP Reimbursement Levels:

- Level 1 - sign the Network Participation Agreement (standard fee schedule)
- Level 2 - 600 points needed
- Level 3 - 800 points needed

The points are allocated in the following four categories (see table for details):

- PCMH Recognition = 225 points
- Improving Health Outcomes = up to 400 points
- Improving Patient Experience = up to 125 points
- Access = up to 200 points
- Reducing Cost = up to 400 points
- **Total Possible Achievable = 1350**

Practices must meet and maintain both criteria below:</p> <p>1 year action plan if practice is above 1.17</p>	<p>Cost Index of 0.93 or below=400 points 0.94- 1.01= 325 1.02- 1.09= 275 1.10- 1.17= 125 1.18- 1.30=75</p>
